



Baptism:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.



HE....HANDED HIM OVER FOR US ALL (Romans 8:32)

what St. Paul doesn't mention in today's passage is how persistent God was in handing Jesus over to us. Neither does Paul talk about how resistent we can be to this great gift. At Christmas, God handed over his Son to us as a gift of peace. Mary and Jospeh welcomed him openly, and a few shepherds embraced him, but the rest of the world seemed pitted against him. Even Herod and all Jerusalem feared him

Yes, God loved us so much that he did not spare his Son. But

Then the Father handed Jesus over to us as a gift of wisdom: "This is my beloved Son," he proclaimed (Matthew 3:17). He sent him to teach us how to live in love with him and each other. But rather than receive Jesus humbly, we questioned his every motive and were hard of heart and slow to believe. On the Mount of Transfiguration, God offered Jesu as a gift of glory: "This is my beloved Son," he said yet again, adding

and trembled at the news of his birth (Matthew 2:3).

an impassioned plea: "Listen to him" (Mark 9:7). Still, even Peter misunderstood the gift. He sought to capture Jesus' glory as a static memorial rather than a living presence. God even used Pilate to hand Jesus over to us, this time as a gift of sacrifice: "Behold, the man!...Take him yourselves and crucify him!" Pilate cried. He didn't even know that he was helping fulfill Jesus' mission. But again we rejected the gift: "Take him away!" we replied (John 19:5, 6:15). On Easter Sunday, God gave Jesus to us again, this time as a gift of forgveness and redemption. And every day since then, he continues to offer Jesus to us in the humble form of bread and wine: "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world." Jesus is here: Accept him. Let him change your heart.

for this year that have not been picked-up. If you are unable to come to the church but would like to have your Offertory box please call the parish office and we can arrange to have it dropped off at your door. We thank everyone who gave so generously throughout the past year and hope for your continued support in 2021.

COMMUNION SERVICES AND LIVE-STREAMED MASS SCHEDULE

Cardinal Collins, Archbishop of Toronto, has given special permission for parishes to continue to offer Communion Services during this period of lockdown. That being said we must follow Worship Safe Protocols and ensure this can be done safely, with no more than 10 people inside the church at a given time, including the priest and usher.



Communion Services will be offered Saturdays from 4:00-5:00p.m. and Sundays 11:00-12:00 noon. Like before you must register your time for the communion service with the parish office (416-694-2811). Jean, will give you your time slot and we ask that you are on time as we want things to run smoothly and efficiently. Please note we are not able to bulk book you for every week at the same time, so as to give everyone the chance to receive communion. Please call weekly for availability. We hope these opportunities provide spiritual comfort to our parish family during this difficult lockdown. Also,

following Archdiocesan mandate and keeping with civil authorities' appeal to restrict activities for now to deal with this pandemic, all public Masses are temporarily suspended. We continue to offer the sacrifice of the Mass daily for your intentions. Temporarily, weekday Masses will be Livestreamed on Monday, and Friday at 9:00 a.m. and on Wednesdays at 7:00 p.m. Sunday Liturgy ~ Mass will be Live-streamed on Sunday at 10:00 a.m. The Church will be open for private prayers Mondays to Friday but only for 10 people at a given time. Church Open for Private Prayer: Monday to Friday 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER

(WDP) has been happening in Canada for almost 100 years! The 2021 service was written by the WDP committee of Vanuatu inspired by the Biblical theme "Build on a Strong Foundation" (Matthew 7; 24-27).

World Day of Prayer has been an important ministry for women as they lead services within their communities for their own denominations and ecumenically year after year. In past years, women received the World Day of Prayer service in the fall, and then gathered to plan, host, and share in coffee and conversation following the service, typically on the first Friday in March. In 2021, service options have expanded. COVID-19 encouraged the production of a full-length World Day of Prayer video service by the Women's Inter-Church Council of Canada to help keep people safe.
