



THIS MAN GOD RAISED ON THE THIRD DAY (Acts 10:34, 37-43)



Alleluia! Christ is risen! What joy we feel when we hear these words at Easter! We have made it through the forty days of Lent. We have walked with Jesus on his journey to the cross in Holy Week. Now we can proclaim the good news of his resurrection and celebrate with all the angels and saints,

But Easter doesn't end today. As a Church, we celebrate Easter as an octave, for a full eight days. We celebrate it as a liturgical season, lasting fifty days, until Pentecost. And we celebrate it every Sunday throughout the year,

EASTER SEASON

The seven weeks of the Easter season are celebrated as one great feast day. St. Athanasius called the entire season "the great Sunday". These fifty days continue the Church's celebration of the Lord's Paschal Mystery. Jesus' suffering, death, resurrection, ascension and sending of the Spirit are celebrated as one event in God's plan of salvation.

The Paschal Candle, blessed at the Easter Vigil, is a reminder of the presence of the Risen Christ among His people and remains in the sanctuary near the ambo (lectern) until Pentecost. It is lit during the Easter season for all liturgical services. Thereafter it is placed near the font and is lighted for baptisms and funerals throughout the year.

The Easter water, also blessed at the Easter Vigil, is used for all baptisms in the Easter season. By ancient tradition, the Old Testament is not read during Masses of the season. The Church expresses the exuberant joy of this season by the much repeated cry of Alleluia! (Praise God!)



DIVINE MERCY

The Divine Mercy Novena which began on Good Friday continues this week in preparation for Mercy Sunday which coincides with the Octave Day and Second Sunday of

Easter on 11th April. We encourage you to say Novena prayers and the Chaplet of Mercy each evening this week in your homes with your family. We will observe Mercy Sunday here in St. Dunstan's with special devotions at **3:00 p.m. next Sunday** that include the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

The message and devotion of Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, a polish nun (1903-1938) who received revelations from Jesus about God's Mercy. The message of Mercy is that God loves us and that we can always call upon and trust in His mercy. We too can be instruments of His mercy to others. This devotion was especially dear to Pope John Paul II who established this feast for the Universal Church in 2000.

Fundamental Rights. We pray for those who risk their lives while fighting for fundamental rights under dictatorships, authoritarian regimes and even in democracies in crisis.




