

Baptism:



Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

RED WEDNESDAY

Around the world, the Pontifical Charity Aid to the Church in Need is promoting the observance of Red Wednesday, November 17 as an occasion to pray for persecuted Christians. The colour red signifies the blood of Christians who continue to be martyred for their faith. Currently, 327 million Christians live in a country where there is religious persecution. Another 178 million live in a country where there is discrimination, for a total of 505 million Christians who are at risk. Although it is difficult to keep a precise count, it is believed that 75% of religiously motivated violence is perpetrated against Christians. In solidarity with Christians who suffer for their faith, we are inviting parishioners to the 7:00 p.m. Mass this Wednesday 17 November and to wear something red if they can.

FIRST COMMUNION REGISTRATION

Parents who wish their children in Grade 2 (or higher grades) to receive, for the first time, the sacraments of Penance and the Holy Eucharist during this school year, are asked to observe the following registration procedure. Letters with Registration Forms have been eligible children sent home with attending St. Dunstan's School. Letters are available from Father Jeff after Sunday Mass for parents of children in other schools. Registration and meeting for parents will take place Sunday, November 28 following the 12:00 noon Mass. Completed Registration Forms along with a copy of the child's baptismal certificate and \$30 to cover the cost of catechetical materials should be returned at this time. Children preparing for the sacraments, like all Catholics, should be in the habit of attending Sunday Mass regularly.
