

Baptism:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

MONTH OF POOR SOULS

November is traditionally a time to remember the faithful departed and pray for their repose.

<u>Visiting a Cemetery</u> The faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed from 1 to 8 November, may gain a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory under the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion and prayer for the Holy Father.

<u>The Books of Remembrance</u> will remain in the church throughout the month. The faithful departed whose names are inscribed will be remembered in the general intercessions at the Sunday Masses in November. Please note that names inscribed in previous years need not be repeated.

Holy Souls Masses All Souls envelopes are available at the Information Desk. Masses will be offered weekly during November for those whose names are submitted with the offering for these Masses.

FIRST COMMUNION REGISTRATION

Parents who wish their children in Grade 2 (or higher grades) to receive, for the first time, the sacraments of Penance and the Holy Eucharist during this school year, are reminded that registration and a meeting for parents will take place today Sunday, November 6 following the 12:00 noon Mass. Completed Registration Forms along with a copy of the child's baptismal certificate and \$20 to cover the cost of catechetical materials should be returned at this time. As well, children preparing for the sacraments, like all Catholics, should be in the habit of attending Sunday Mass regularly.

NEW FLOORING

Next week, work will begin to install new flooring in the sanctuary of the church. This project is financed by the Family of Faith funds allocated to St. Dunstan's. Many thanks to parishioners who supported the Family of Faith campaign. While this work is underway, Mass will be celebrated in the parish lounge.

SUNDAY MISSALS 2022-2023

A new liturgical year will start on November 27, the First Sunday of Advent. As you know, following the Second Vatican Council, the Church adopted a threeyear cycle of Sunday readings from the Bible. This coming liturgical year is designated Year A in the cycle of readings and features the Gospel of Matthew. New Sunday missals are available after Mass at the Information Desk and at the rectory during office hours for \$5 each. The complete Mass for each Sunday with readings is found in this missal, as well as a selection of private prayers and hymns. It is ideal for those who would like to prepare for Sunday Mass by reading the scripture passages ahead of time. It is suggested that those who purchase a personal missal, write their name inside the cover to distinguish it from the missals provided in the pews which are stamped with the parish name. We have a limited supply for sale so get your own copy early.

Parishioners are encouraged to wear a poppy in remembrance.
