JANUARY 1, SOLEMNITY OF MARY THE HOLY MOTHER OF GOD

On 1 January, the Octave (eighth) Day of Christmas, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother

of God. After celebrating the birth of Christ on 25 December, it is only fitting to celebrate the Blessed Virgin who consented to God's plan of salvation and became the Mother of the Redeemer, the Word made flesh in her womb by the power of the Holy Spirit. "Mother of God" is Mary's greatest privilege and title. On this great feast day, may Our Lady inspire us to say our own "yes" to God and welcome the Saviour into our lives and hearts. Also, on the first day of the civil calendar, the Church observes the World Day of Peace, praying for peace among nations and an end to war and violence.



Please note that 1 January is a holyday of obligation in Canada.

PEACE

Since the pontificate of Saint Paul VI, the Catholic Church has observed 1 January as the World Day of Peace. We know that peace is a great blessing and one of the deepest longings of the human heart. We also know that real and lasting peace cannot co-exist where there is injustice, oppression and poverty. Building peace is everyone's



responsibility. Each person must be committed to creating conditions that will foster peace, beginning with oneself and one's own family. The "seeds" needed to build up peace in the family and in the world are respect, humility, self-control, patience and tolerance, inner strength, generosity, goodness and kindness, joy, justice and prayer. In this Christmas season we rejoice that Jesus has given us the sacraments of Reconciliation and the Holy Eucharist so that we could live in peace and communion with God and one another. As we commemorate Mary, the Mother of God on New Year's Day and after a year marred by so much violence, turmoil and sickness, let us resolve to pray often the rosary for peace in the world.

1923 ~~ CENTENNIAL OF ST. DUNSTAN'S PARISH ~~ 2023

New Year's ushers in our Centennial Year marking 100 years since our parish was established by Archbishop Neil McNeil. The first Mass was celebrated on October 17, 1923 in the original church (the present church is the third on this site) and on October 28, 1923 the church was solemnly blessed by His Grace the Archbishop.

The opening celebrations today on New Year's Eve with Bishop Robert Kasun presiding, along with a guest choir

and musicians providing the music, and followed by a reception in the parish lounge, is the first of a number of special Centennial events planned throughout the year. Other celebrations include the following: The Junior Choir from the renowned St. Michael's Choir School will sing at the 5:00 p.m. Mass on 15 April, the Saturday after Easter, and give a 30 minute concert following the Mass. Bishop Kasun will join us again to celebrate the Solemnity of our Patron, Saint Dunstan of Canterbury on Friday, May 19 at 7:00 p.m. A parish picnic is planned for the Victoria Day weekend. In July we are planning a parish trip to London, England where we plan to take a day trip to Canterbury to vist the tomb of Saint Dunstan (more information to follow soon). The Cardinal Archbishop will celebrate the



12:00 noon Mass on October 15 and a Dinner Dance will be held on Saturday, October 21. All parishioners are invited to these special events. If you have friends or relatives who have attended our parish in the past, let them know about our 100th Anniversary and invite them to join in our celebrations.
