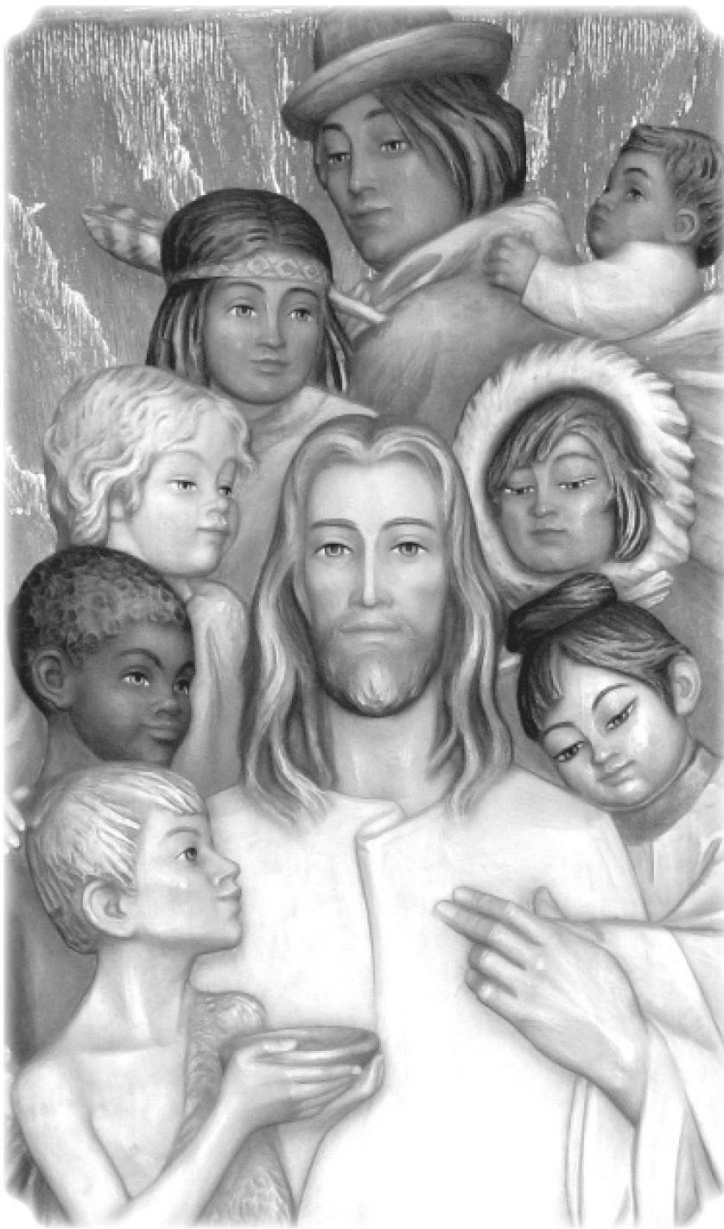

## Baptism:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

## Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

**LENTEN FILM SERIES**

During Lent, several inspirational films will be shown on Sundays, March 5, 12, 19, and April 2 at 6:00 p.m. (when it is dark enough to show movies in the church).



This Sunday, **“The Reluctant Saint”** tells the true and amazing story of Saint Joseph (Giuseppe) of Cupertino, the “Flying Friar,” a seventeenth century Italian Franciscan priest, starring Maximilian Schell and Ricardo Montalban. This 1962 black and white film has a running time of approximately 1 hour 40 minutes. The simple, clumsy and poorly-educated peasant Giuseppe was seemingly an unlikely candidate for religious life, the priesthood or canonization, and film critics initially did not regard this movie very favourably. A modern day critic, however, Steven Greydanus for the National Catholic Register, praises the movie as “authentic” and “persuasive”, extolling the “sweet simplicity, childlike innocence, uncomprehending patience and uncomplicated joy” of the saint from Cupertino, calling him “a true son of Saint Francis”.

Come and see why Saint Joseph of Cupertino is the patron of aviators and astronauts and why Italian students seek his intercession before their exams.

Next Sunday, March 12: **“Footprints”**, a recent film about a priest and 11 young men walking the Camino (road) to the Shrine of Santiago de Compostela in northern Spain.
