The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

**BUILDING MAINTENANCE**

Many thanks to parishioners who support our monthly Building Maintenance Fund. Bishop Kasun has been with us twice this year, for our opening celebrations on New Year's Eve and for the Feast of St. Dunstan on May 19. His Grace the Archbishop is scheduled to visit St. Dunstan's on Sunday, October 15 to celebrate the 12:00 noon Mass with us in honour of our Centennial. (It was in October 1923 that the first Mass was celebrated in the original church, and the church was blessed by Archbishop Neil McNeil).
