Baptism:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

November is traditionally a time to remember the faithful departed and pray for their repose.

Visiting a Cemetery The faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed from 1 to 8 November, may gain a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory under the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion and prayer for the Holy Father.

The Books of Remembrance will remain in the church throughout the month. The faithful departed whose names are inscribed will be remembered in the general intercessions at the Sunday Masses in November. Please note that names inscribed in previous years need not be repeated.

Holy Souls Masses All Souls envelopes are available at the Information Desk. Masses will be offered weekly during November for those whose names are submitted with the offering for these Masses.

REMEMBRANCE DAY

Saturday, November 11 is Remembrance Day which is not only a civic observance to honour those who made the supreme sacrifice of their lives in time of war, but also a special day of prayer in Canada, to pray for their eternal repose as well as for peace, and for the innocent victims of war and aggression. Parishioners are encouraged to wear a poppy in remembrance.



FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Enrolment of eligible children in Grade 2 and up for First Holy Communion will take place this Sunday afternoon, November 5, following the 12 noon Mass with an important meeting for parents. Registration forms are available at the Information desk. Completed forms should be submitted at the meeting with a copy of the child's baptismal certificate and \$20 to cover the cost of catechetical materials.



CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION

Letters with Registration Forms have been distributed to eligible students at St. Dunstan's School in Grades 7 and 8. Letters are available from the receptionist after Sunday Mass for students in other schools or adults who wish to be confirmed. **Registration and meeting for parents and candidates will take place Sunday, November 19 following the 12:00 noon Mass.** Completed Registration Forms should be submitted at this meeting along with a copy of the candidate's baptismal certificate and \$20 to cover the cost of catechetical materials. Candidates should be in the habit of attending Sunday Mass regularly.



ALTAR SERVER AWARDS

Last Saturday, October 28, two St. Dunstan's altar servers were among the recipients of the Bishop's Award for Service at a special ceremony at St. Paul's Basilica presided by our Regional Bishop Robert Kasun.
