

Baptism:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

LENTEN FILM SERIES

This Sunday we begin our Lenten Film Series with the 1966 film "A Man for All Seasons," the story of Saint Thomas More, Chancellor of England who was martyred in 1535 for refusing to recognize King Henry VIII as the Head of the Church in England, choosing to die rather than betray his conscience and his Catholic faith. This film which won six Academy Awards, incuding best actor, best director and best picture, is based on Robert Bolt's award winning play of the same name which was a hit on Broadway and around the world. Running time 2 hours.

Next Sunday, "The Shoes of the Fisherman" a 1968 movie based on the bestselling novel by Morris L. West. This film tells the story of a Russian bishop, a newly freed political prisoner who is elected the first Slavic pope and the first non-Italian in several centuries. The new pontiff is elected at a critical time when the world is on the brink of a nuclar catastophe. Although a work of fiction, this film, with its various subplots, is inspiring with a relevant message for every age. This story was considered "prophetic" when ten years after the movie, Pope John Paul II was elected the first Slavic pope and the first non-Italian in modern history. Running time is approximately 2 hours, 40 minutes. Please note, the movies in the Lenten Film Series are free and showtime is 6:00 p.m.

SHARELIFE APPEAL 2024

The first collection for ShareLife is scheduled for the weekend of March 16-17. Recently Archbishop Leo sent a letter to parishes (see copy on the bulletin board), thanking everyone for the response to last year's appeal which raised a record \$14.2 million.
