

If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

TWO SOLEMNITIES THIS WEEK

This week the Catholic Church observes two important solemnities (the highest rank of liturgical days): the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist on Monday, June 24 (*please note the change of Mass to* 7:00 p.m.) and Saints Peter and Paul on Saturday, June 29 at 10:00 a.m. as usual, both these solemnities will be celebrated with a Solemn Mass. In Canada, Saint John the Baptist is important as the special Patron of French-Canadians – June 24 is a holiday in Quebec. Saints Peter and Paul celebrates the two founders of the Church in Rome, Saint Peter the Prince of the Apostles and the first Pope to whom Jesus entrusted the keys to the kingdom of heaven, and Saint Paul, the great missionary and apostle to the gentiles.
