

## **Baptism**:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

## Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

#### **MISSION CO-OP APPEAL**

Each year, the Development Office of the Archdiocese invites a missionary group to every parish to share about their mission work. The appeal here in St. Dunstan's will be the **weekend of July 20—21**. We will welcome the Foundation for Children in Need (FCN), a lay Catholic organization based in Arlington Heights, IL. FCN serves the poor in the interior villages of India. Mr. Tom Chitta, the founder of FCN will join us to talk about their work.

FCN sponsors the education and daily needs of 2000 children and college students. They provide free medical check-ups and medicine to thousands of needy children. Over the past nine years, FCN has provided free corrective surgeries to more than 2000 children born with cleft lip and cleft palate. Next weekend we welcome Tom Chitta and encourage you to generously support their missionary endeavours. #### **QUEBEC SHRINES**

Parishioners visiting the province of Quebec this summer are reminded of two important anniversaries this year: 2024 is the fourth centenary of Canada's consecration to Saint Joseph by the first missionaries to Canada, the Franciscan Recollet Fathers in 1624. For 400 years now, Saint Joseph has been the Principal Patron of our country. This year consider a pilgrimage to Saint Joseph's Oratory in Montreal founded by Saint Brother Andre, the largest church in the world dedicated to Saint Joseph where the fourth centenary will be commemorated with a number of significant events.
