

Baptism:

Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

Letters with Registration Forms have been distributed to eligible students at St.Dunstan's School in Grades 7



A NEW CARDINAL

Pope Francis has announced that Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto, the Most Rev. Francis Leo

will be elevated to the College of Cardinals. The announcement came at the conclusion of the Holy Father's Sunday Angelus in Rome on October 6, 2024.

The Holy Father will hold a Consistory for the creation of the new Cardinals on December 8, 2024 at the Vatican.



Twenty-one new Cardinals from around the world were included in the announcement.

Cardinal-elect Leo commented on the appointment:

"I am humbled and honoured to receive this appointment from the Holy Father. I pray and rely on the prayers of the faithful in Toronto that I will be a worthy servant of the Lord Jesus in fulfiling my respnsibilities as a member of the College of Cardinals and to continue in my primary role as shepherd of the faithful of the Archdiocese of Toronto. I entrust to the Blessed Mother Mary, myself and this new ministry of service to the Universal Church and to the Successor of St. Peter, the Pope."

Cardinals serve as close advisors to the Holy Father and participate whenever there is a conclave, as voting members, to select the next Pope. Following today's announcement, including the new Cardinal electors, there will be 256 cardinals, including 141 Cardinal electors. Cardinals are eligible to vote in conclave until they reach their 80th birthday.

TODAY IS WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday during October became known as World Mission Sunday. Catholics throughout the world are invited to pray for and give to the missions. The collection is organized by the Pontifical Missions Society. The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses under the responsibility of the of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. As agreed by the Holy See and the Bishops of Canada, a portion of the Canadian contributions to this collection will assist six dioceses in Northern Canada which for many years had also been under the jurisdiction of the Congregation.

The three-year process of listening and dialogue, undertaken between 2021 and 2024 has garnered participation from Catholics worldwide. Gatherings in Rome over the past three years have helped synthesize feedback and fostered dialogue with lay, consecrated and ordained delegates representing the Church globally.
