

Baptism:

Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.



HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

We wish all mothers a Happy Mother's Day on this special occasion. Pope Pius XII called mothers the "heart" of the family. We are all grateful to our mothers for giving us the gift of life and for fostering our life of faith. Motherhood, in some sense, is the vocation of all women: to nuture and enhance life. Therefore we must also thank all women who have excercised a motherly role towards us ~ sisters, aunts, godmothers, teachers, nurses, religious and others. We remember too in a special way the souls of our mothers who have gone before us. May they rest in the Peace of the Lord.

In a letter to all mothers of the Archdiocese, Cardinal Leo writes:

On this Mother's Day I wish to extend my blessings on all mothers. Thank you for everything you do for your families, the Church and the world. Through your daily acts of love, often hidden and humble but

profoundly meaningful, you witness to God's love and are a sign of hope in the world. I encourage and pray for you and all mothers who embrace their vocation. May you seek daily to build the foundation of your children's lifelong relationship with God and be beacons of hope in the world. Please know that you are loved and appreciated and that your motherhood is not only important, it is sacred. May the Blessed Mother intercede and inspire you every day as "Catholic Moms"; may your love for the Risen Lord increase daily, and may you continue your Pilgrimage of Hope in this life as an inspirational example of God's love whose fullness we will experience in the life to come.

INTERREGNUM

The period between the death of a pope and the election of his successor is called the *interregnum*, meaning "between the reigns". As you know, the conclave to elect a new pope began last Wednesday, May 7. That evening St. Dunstan's celebrated the proper Mass for the Election of the Pope. After the official period of mourning for Pope Francis concluded on May 4, we began praying for the Cardinal electors at all the Masses, that they may be guided by the Holy Spirit in their deliberations. This bulletin went to print before the conclave began, so we may have a new pope already, in which case we pray that God may bless him with wisdom and strength to carry out his important role as Bishop of Rome and Vicar of Christ for the Universal Church. If the conclave has been inconclusive so far, we pray that the election of a new pope will come soon so that we may hear the news "Nuntio vobis gaudium magnum. Habemus Papam" from the balcony of St. Peter's (I announce to you great joy. We have a Pope).

Catholics traditionally observe the month of May as a time to honour Our Lady as Mother and Queen with special devotions, recalling her irreplacable role in God's plan of salvation. Our parish will have a Marian Celebration later this month.
