#### **SOLEMNITY OF PENTECOST**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, one of the Church's greatest feasts, marking the completion of Christ's earthly mission and the beginning of the Spirit's mission in the Church. Today the Church implores anew the outpouring of the gifts of the Holy Spirit on all her children. This feast can be considered the birthday of the Church. On this day the catholicity of the Church was demonstrated as Peter's preaching was heard and understood in the various languages of the pilgrims in Jerusalem. From the Holy City, the Gospel was proclaimed to the ends of the earth. Today we celebrate the perennial youthfulness of the Church.

#### **CORPUS CHRISTI**

This important feast commemorates the central role of the Holy Eucharist in the Church's life and worship. The celebration of the Eucharist, most often called the Holy Mass, is the distinctive act of worship for Christians. For



almost two thousand years, Christians have been gathering especially on Sunday, the Lord's Day, to celebrate the Eucharist in memory of Jesus as He commanded at the Last Supper. Adoration of Christ truly present in the Holy Eucharist whether reserved in the tabernacle or exposed in the monstrance on the altar has been encouraged by numerious popes and saints.

This year we will observe Corpus Christi with a procession inside the church following the *12:00 noon Mass Sunday*, *June 22*, followed by devotions and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Everyone is invited to stay after Mass as we pay homage to our eucharistic Lord and King.
