

Baptism:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.

CANADA DAY

July 1 is celebrated as Canada's birthday, this year marking the 158th anniversary of Confederation. Canadian Catholics should seek to be witnesses to Christ in Canada and the world, and continue working to influence those in government to act from the Christian principles on which our modern country was founded. On this Canada Day, let us thank God for our beautiful country and pray for our Sovereign, our government, our armed forces and all our fellow citizens.

In addition to the Latin motto "A mari usque ad mare" ("From sea to sea", Psalm 72:8), the Royal Arms of Canada also includes this inscription "Desiderantes meliorem patriam" from the New Testament (Heb 11:16): "They desire a better country". This verse which is also the motto of the Order of Canada, our highest civilian honour, first of all refers to the longing to be with God in our heavenly homeland. As part of the Coat of Arms it refers to our desire to make our country better, a reminder for all Canadians. As Catholics we do this by praying and working to improve society and make it more just and human. Certainly, we ought to do this by letting our light shine through our good example of following Christ. The best thing we can do is proudly and publicly live our Catholic faith and shine the Gospel light on the important issues of our time. The preamble to the Charter of Rights and Freedoms which is part of the Constitution Act, states that Canada is founded on principles that recognize "the supremacy of God". If God is supreme, then people of faith must oppose man-made laws which contradict God's laws concerning the sanctity of human life, marriage and the family. This is our duty not only as Catholics, but as Canadians as well, as our foundational document makes clear. We are only insisting that the government, courts, and political parties obey the Constitution.

PASTORAL LETTER FROM CARDINAL LEO

Cardinal Leo, Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto, has released "*That Blessed Upper Room*," a pastoral letter inviting the faithful of the archdiocese to reflect together on the significance of The Upper Room in our lives, our families and in our communities of faith as this story is so directly connected to pivotal events in the life of Jesus and of the early Church. The letter is divided into nine chapters, drawing on dimensions of our Catholic Christian life. In the words of Cardinal Leo:

"This resource can be the object of a parish sharing group or an informal gathering of friends. The reflections can be used as inspiration for summer reading or for Advent or Lenten activities or for a personal retreat. You can, for instance, take one question per day and let it accompany you or set some quiet time per week; a short 15 minutes, to read a paragraph and ask yourself a question that is proposed. Studied and reflected upon individually or in community, whether in families, parishes, schools and religious houses, I pray that this small contribution will help readers and faithful come to a more profound sense of faith, a more mature relationship with the Lord and to a transforming experience of grace."
