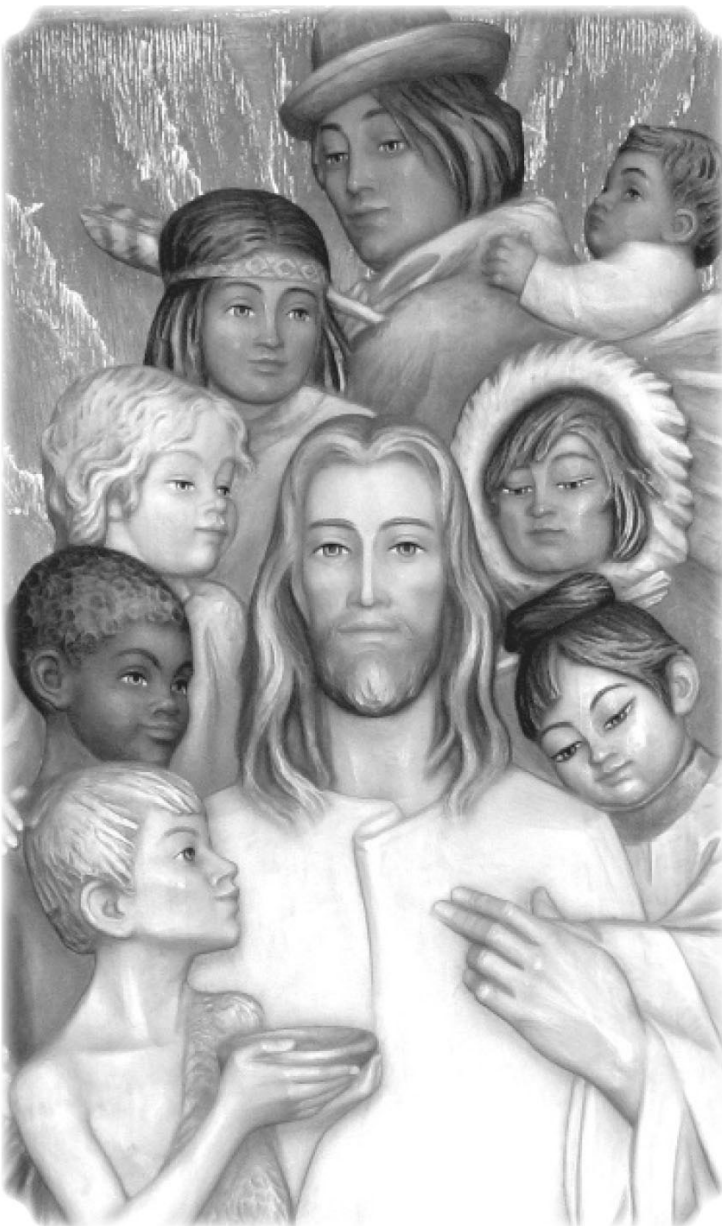

Baptism:

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.



EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLES EXHIBITION

Our parish will host the Vatican-approved Exhibition of Eucharistic Miracles from around the world, designed and created by the newly canonized Saint Carlo Acutis. Even before his death at the early age of 15, Carlo had caught the attention of the Vatican when he used his computer skills to create this exhibit detailing eucharistic miracles. The exhibit will be here at **St. Dunstan's 25-30 October** with the church open for special hours of viewing daily. The exhibit features a series of panels, each telling the story of a particular miracle. Carlo's purpose in creating this exhibit was to increase awareness of the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament and promote Eucharistic adoration. ***At the Sunday Masses, October 26, the faithful also will have an opportunity to venerate a relic of Saint Carlo.***

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY – OCTOBER 19

At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday during October became known as World Mission Sunday. Catholics throughout the world are invited to pray for and give to the missions. The collection is organized by the Pontifical Missions Society. The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses under the responsibility of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. As agreed by the Holy See and the Bishops of Canada, a portion of the Canadian contributions to this collection will assist six dioceses in Northern Canada which for many years had also been under the jurisdiction of the Congregation.

FATHER JEFF'S PILGRIMAGE

Our pastor has returned from his pilgrimage to Lourdes, Assisi and Rome for the Jubilee Year, during which he remembered parishioners and friends of St. Dunstan's in his prayers at the various shrines. In all three locations, the crowds of pilgrims were encouraging signs of faith and included many families and young people. Father was in Assisi on October 4 to celebrate the feast of Saint Francis who is the patron of Italy. Among the dignitaries present for the feast was the President of Italy who encouraged Italians in their Catholic faith which is so integral to their history and culture. In Assisi, many pilgrims spent time lining up to visit the tomb of recently-canonized Carlo Acutis. In Rome enormous crowds passed through the Holy Doors of the four Papal Basilicas of St. Peter's, St. Paul's outside the Walls, St. John Lateran and St. Mary Major's to gain the plenary indulgence with a devout visit and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father, sacramental confession and eucharistic communion. Large crowds attended Pope Leo's General Audience, including thousands of religious priests, brothers and sisters who were in Rome for the Jubilee celebration of Consecrated life. As Pilgrims of Hope, may we all join in giving thanks on this 2025th Anniversary of the birth of the Saviour.

HANDICRAFTS FROM THE HOLY LAND

Every few years, the "Handicraft Holy Land Christians" visit St. Dunstan's and many other parishes to sell unique hand-carved olive wood religious objects made by Christian families in Bethlehem. These will be available for purchase next weekend October 25-26 in the parish lounge after all the Sunday Masses, including the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Vigil. Purchasing these items is a way of connecting with the Holy Land and supporting the local economy which helps to preserve a Christian presence in the Holy Land.





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
