

Second and Fourth Sunday of the Month by appointment only, after completion of a Baptismal Preparation Class. Please pick-up a Baptismal Package from the parish office, read, complete and return same before registering to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Upon class completion a date will be set for the Baptism.

Marriage:

The Church asks all couples, whether they are to be married here or overseas, to contact the parish 1 year in advance of their planned date of marriage. Couples are also expected to attend and complete a Marriage Preparation Course. If either party has previously gone through any form of marriage, civil or religious, the priest is not to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted.




PLEASE REMEMBER GOD'S CHURCH AMONGST YOUR BLESSINGS AND IN YOUR WILL.



This year marks the 50th Anniversary of ShareLife which was established by Archbishop Philip Pocock in 1976. Previously, Catholic Charities were funded by the United Way, but when that organization decided to include agencies which supported abortion and contraception, the Archbishop withdrew Catholic Charities and ShareLife was born. ShareLife also supports the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace with its projects in the Third World, various mission endeavours and St. Augustine's Seminary. The Archdiocese has set our parish a goal of \$30,500.00 for this year's campaign. Please be generous to this important collection which helps 150,000 individuals and families here in the Archdiocese and around the world. The first collection will be held the weekend of March 21-22. Our seminarian, Emile Tumaliuan will speak at the Masses the weekend of March 14-15 on behalf of ShareLife.

CHALICE

This weekend Deacon Philip Allard will be making an appeal for **Chalice**, Canada's largest Catholic Child Sponsorship organization. Our deacon is a Chalice spokesperson and has made this appeal periodically at St. Dunstan's and other parishes. Sponsorship provides education, nutrition and health care to 50,000 children in 15 developing countries around the world. Father Pat Cosgrove, President and Founder of Chalice says, "I am telling you from personal experience that you will feel the great joy that comes to those who embrace Christ's command to care for our neighbours".




40 CANS FOR LENT


DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME
