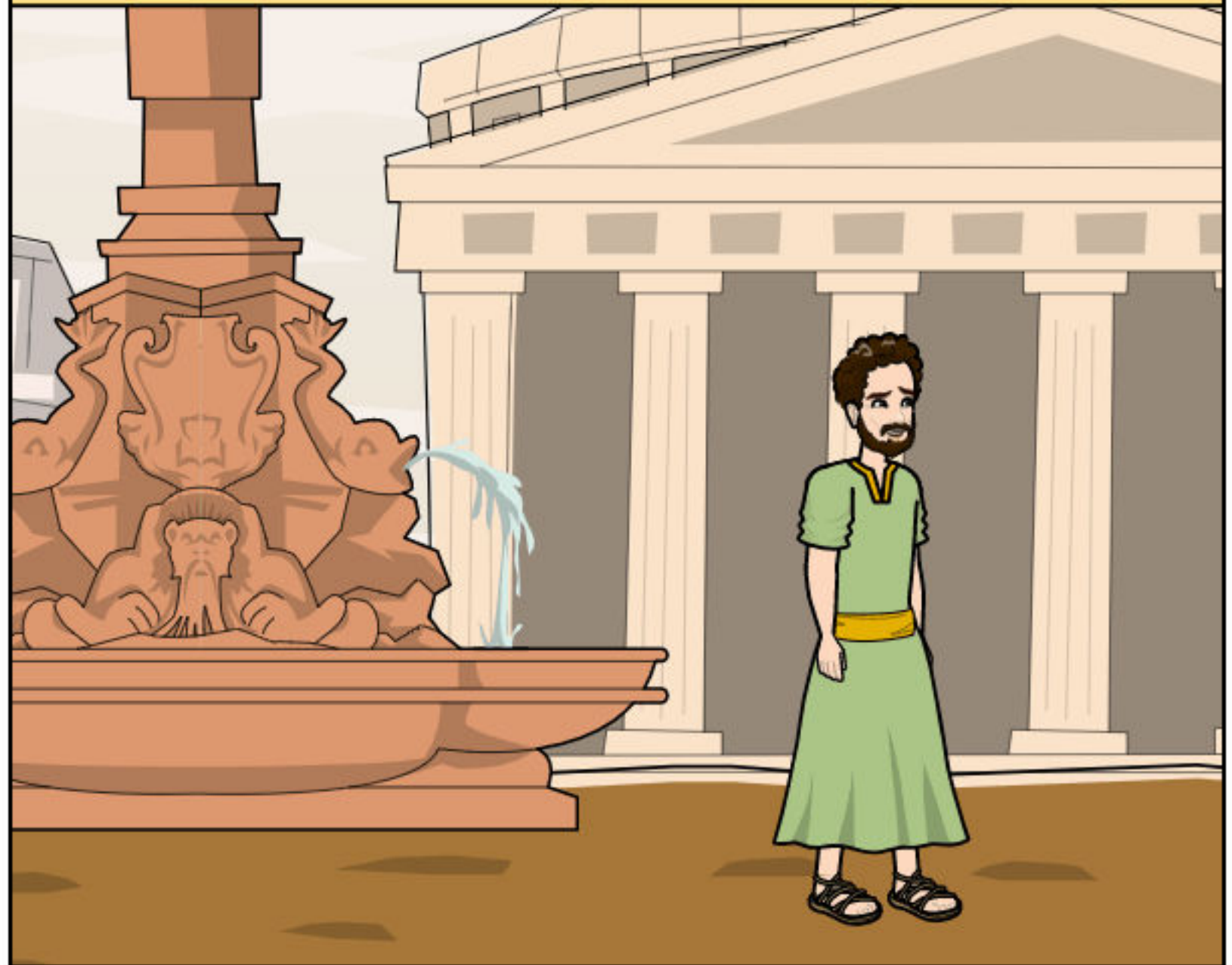


12th day of Lent

(Romans 8:31b)

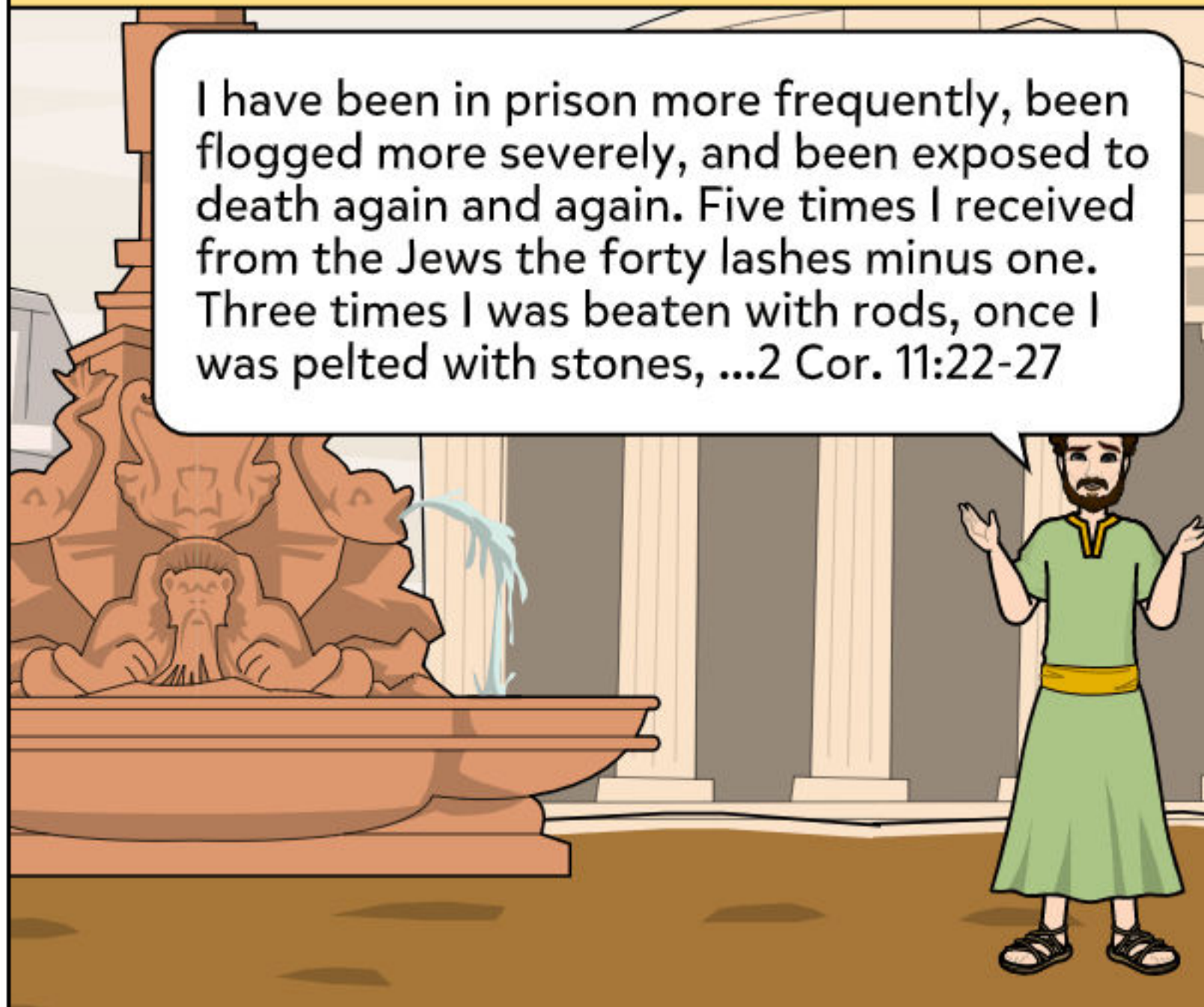


This is Paul, one of the most important pillars of Christianity, considered an apostle of Christ. He suffered so much for his faith in Jesus and for spreading the faith far and wide
