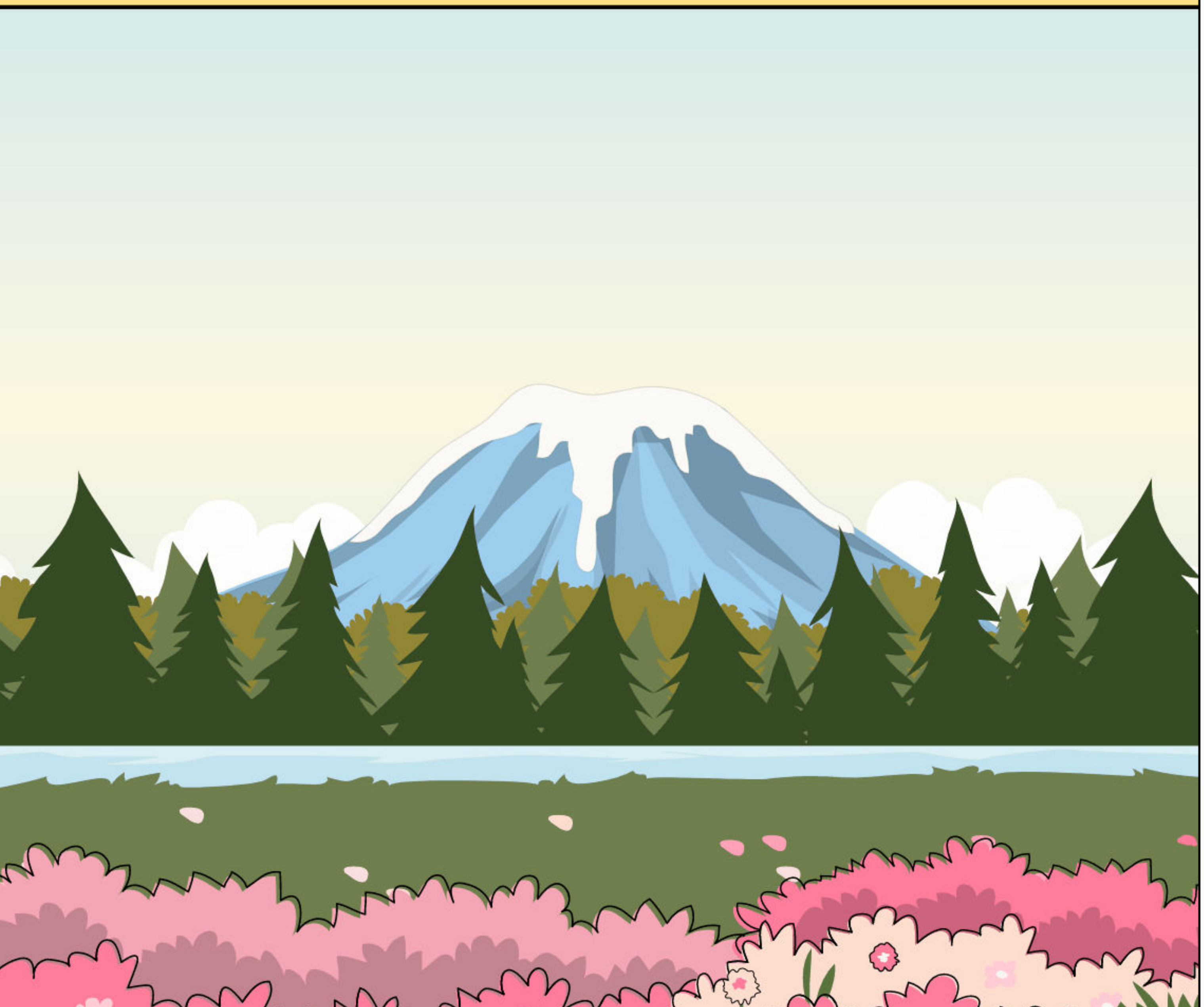
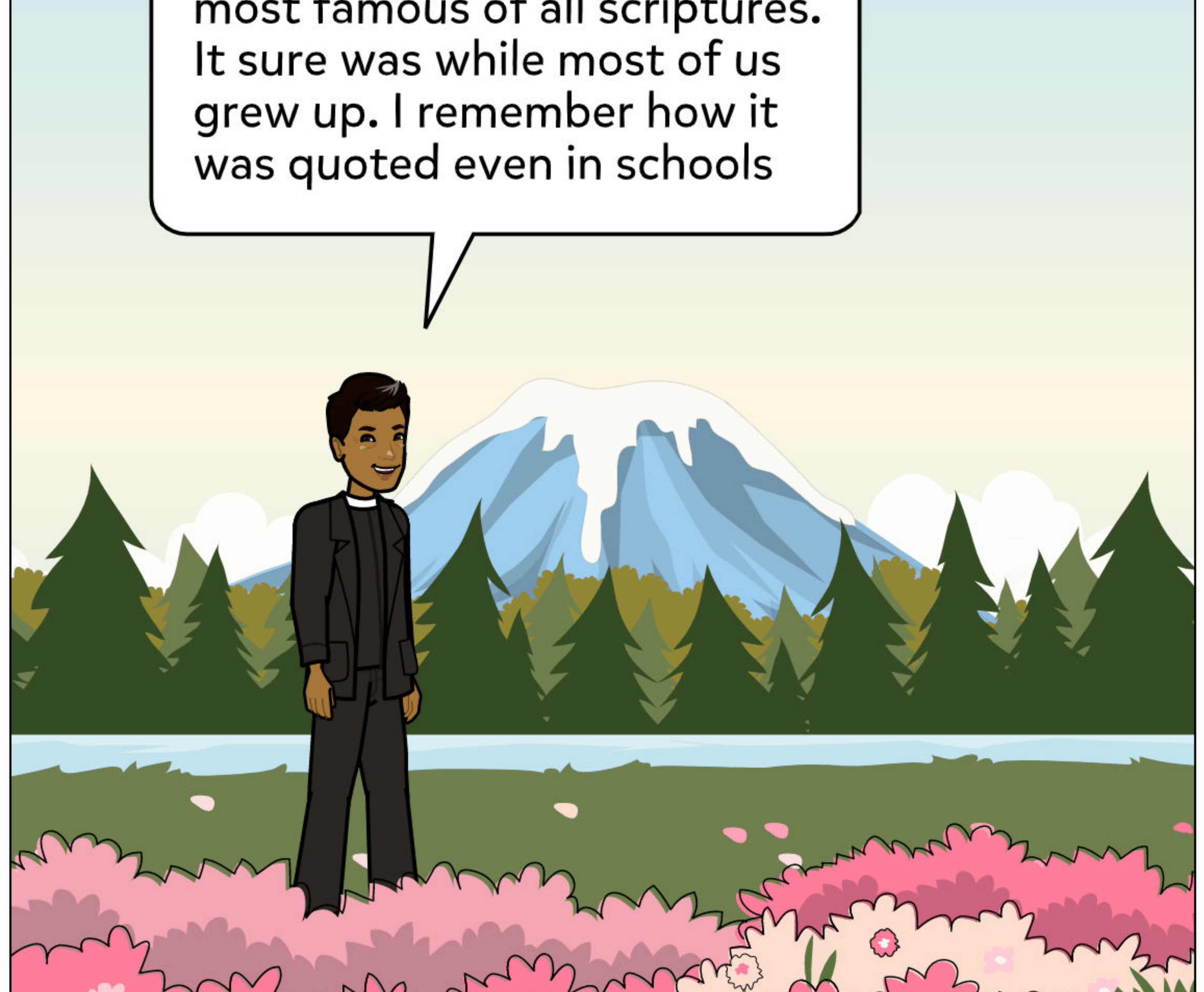


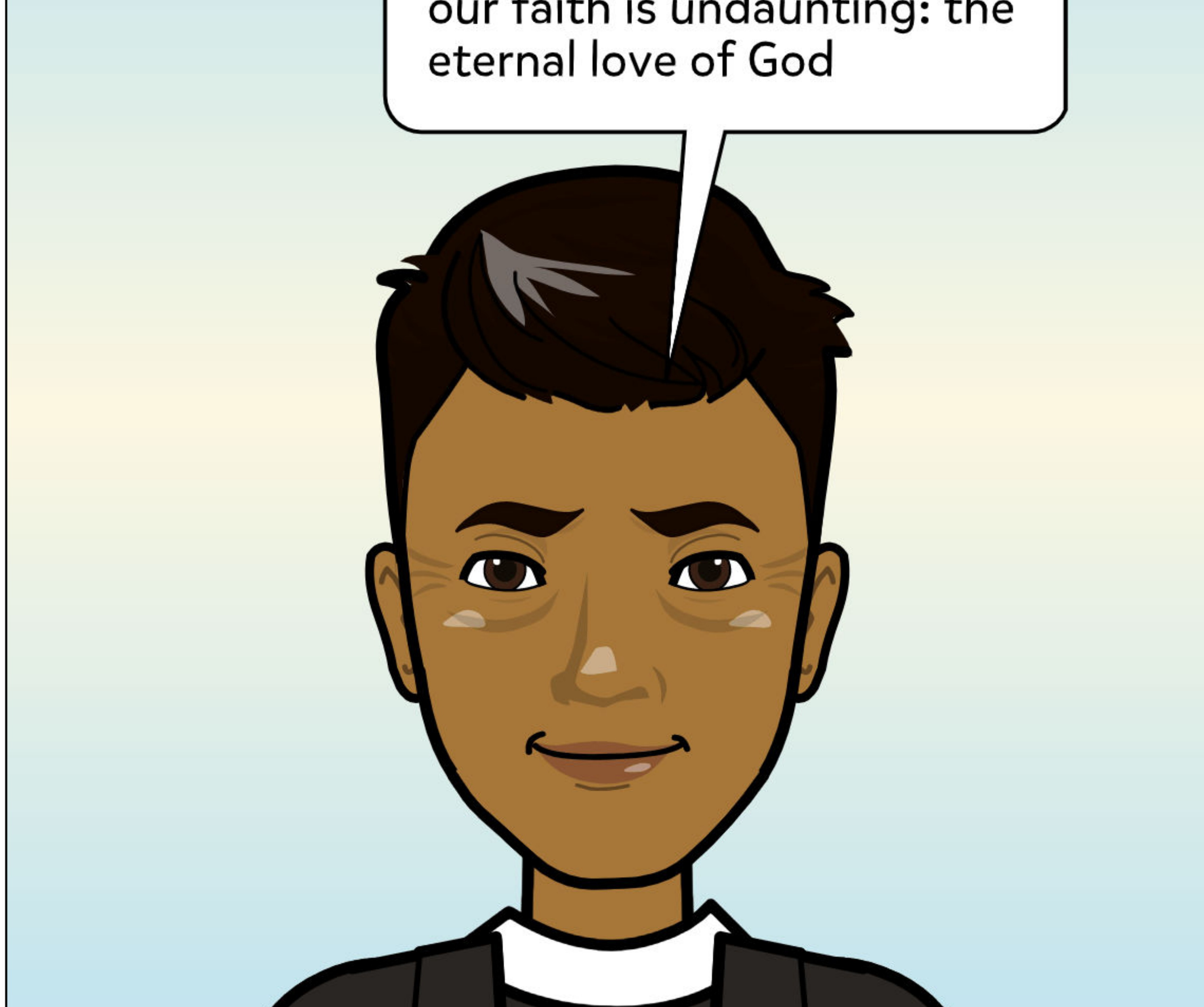
God so loved the world that he gave his only-begotten Son, so that everyone who believes in him might have eternal life. (John 3:16)



That quotation from the gospel of John is one of the most famous of all scriptures. It sure was while most of us grew up. I remember how it was quoted even in schools



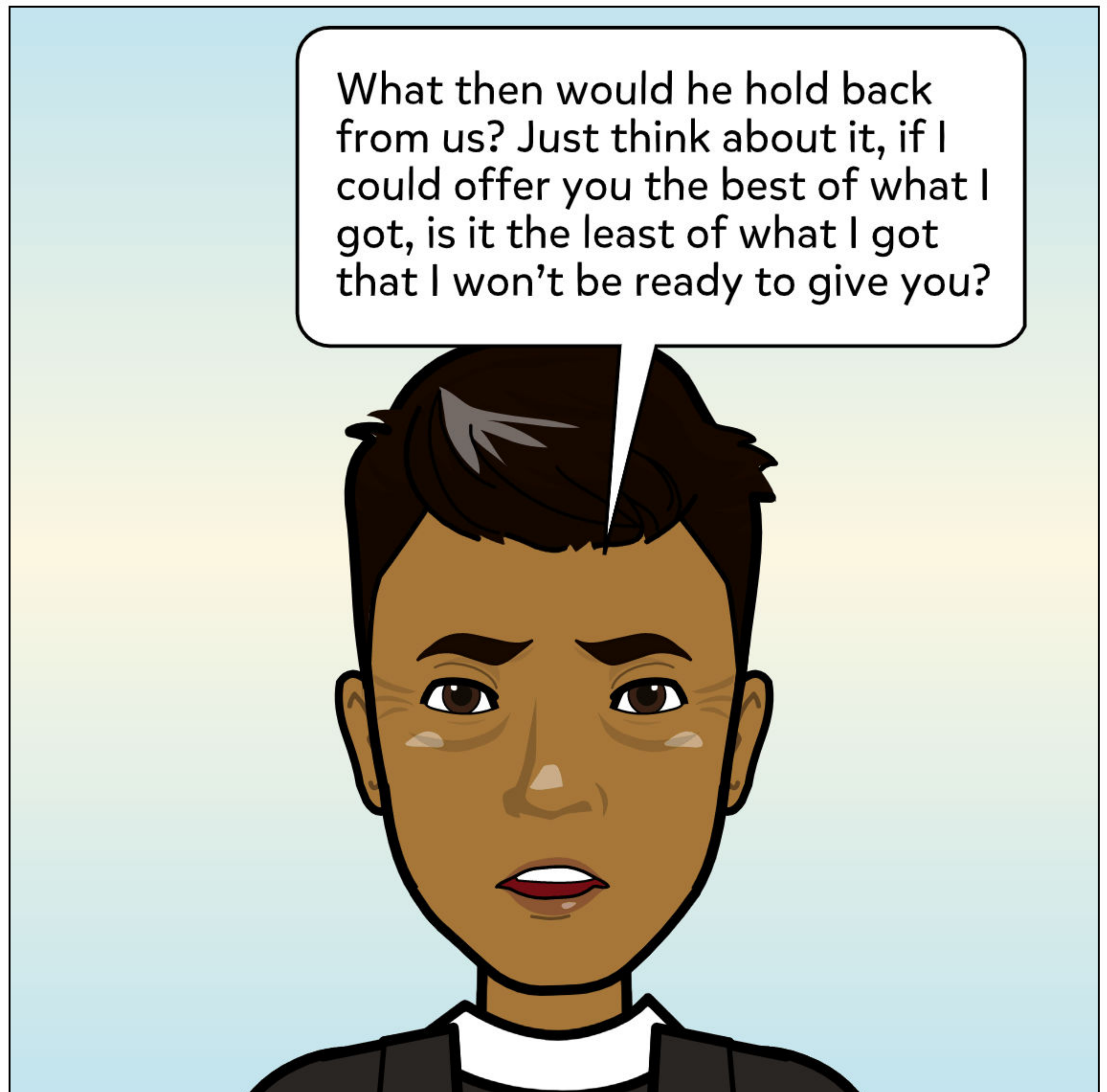
And necessarily so guys, for it embodies the very reason our faith is undaunting: the eternal love of God
