

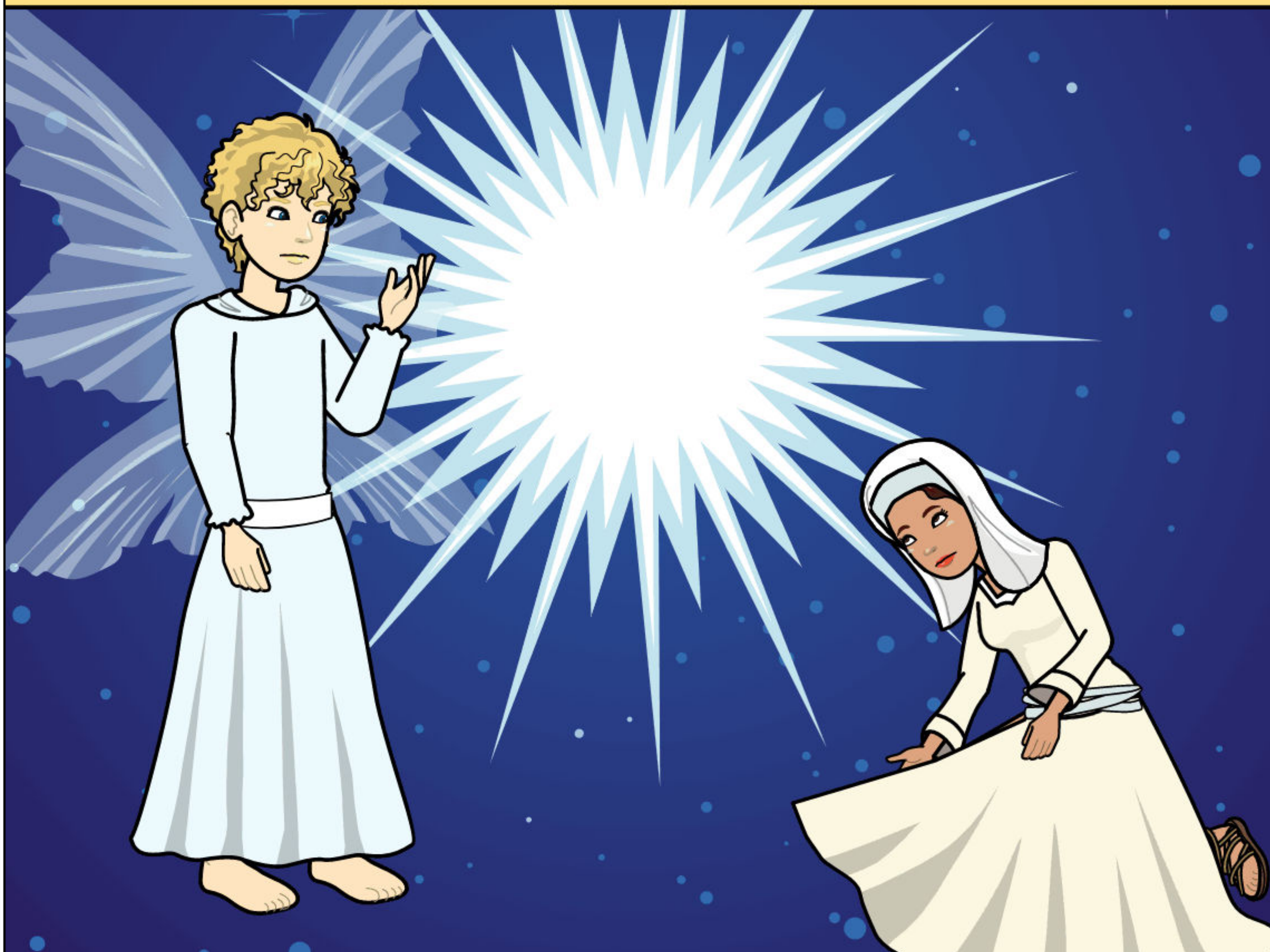
The Word of God became flesh and made his dwelling among us; and we saw his glory. (John 1:14b)
